As a registered charity, 50% of our income comes from sponsorship and donations, and each year brings new financial challenges - for programming, access, education, outreach, or to reinvent how we deliver a Festival in the midst of a global pandemic. Therefore, we rely on donations from our Patrons: the behind-the-scenes heroes of our story, whose generosity makes what we do possible. They've supported various crucial site improvements. They help us bring a diverse range of high-profile authors to Edinburgh from all over the world. And, thanks to them, our outreach programme now runs year round, helping to bring the magic of the Book Festival to people who might never visit our site in August.

For a regular contribution of anything from just a few pounds per month to a few thousand pounds per year, you can become a bigger part of continuing the story of the Edinburgh International Book Festival.



Becoming a Patron is as easy as opening a book. You can support at whatever level suits you, whether it's £20 or £2,000. And if you use Gift Aid it will increase the value of your gift to us by 25% - at no extra cost to you.

Some examples of the difference your donation can make:

£10

a month will help a young person take part in regular creative writing sessions

£15

a month would provide live captioning for one live-streamed event.

£20

a month will cover an author's appearance fee

£100

a month will help to fund an educational event outwith our Festival site helping us to instil a love of literature in people who are unable to visit us.

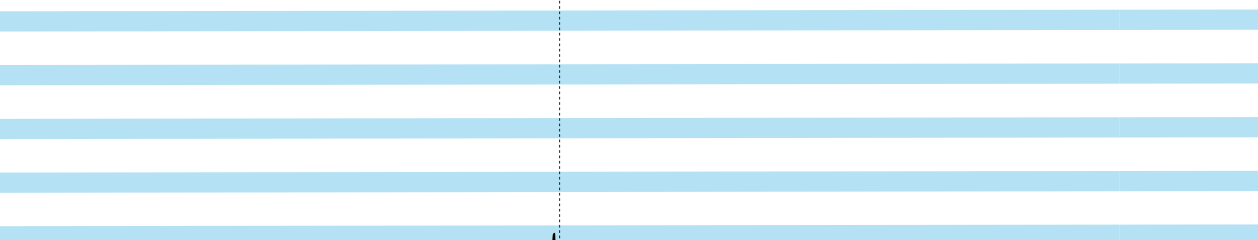

THE DIRECT DEBIT GUARANTEE

- This Guarantee is offered by all Banks and Building Societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits.
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit Edinburgh International Book Festival will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request Edinburgh International Book Festival to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit by Edinburgh International Book Festival or your Bank or Building society you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your Bank or Building society.
- If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when Edinburgh International Book Festival asks you to.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your Bank or Building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.
